The White's seahorse, also known as the Sydney seahorse, is found only along Australia's east coast, making it a very special native species. These tiny seahorses live in seagrass meadows, sponge gardens and even on underwater structures in places like Sydney Harbour. Sadly, their numbers have declined because of habitat loss, pollution and coastal development, and they are now listed as Endangered.
